Perfect Tenses - Time Expressions

Have you ever been to London?

NEVER = mai Position: between AUX and PARTICIPLE

I have **never** drunk absenta.

FOR + period of time

I have been learning English for 10 years.

SINCE + point in time

John has worked there since 2010.

I still haven't found what I'm looking for

YET = ja (?) or encara (-) Position: at the end of the sentence

Has she finished yet?

They haven't started the work yet.

ALREADY = ja (+) Position: between AUX and PARTICIPLE

They have already arrived.

She has just called.
