

Perfect Tenses - Time Expressions

EVER = alguna vegada *Position: after Subject*

Have you **ever** been to London?

NEVER = mai *Position: between AUX and PARTICIPLE*

I have **never** drunk absenta.

FOR + period of time

I have been learning English **for** 10 years.

SINCE + point in time

John has worked there **since** 2010.

STILL = encara *Position: always after the subject*

I still haven't found what I'm looking for

YET = ja (?) or encara (-) *Position: at the end of the sentence*

Has she finished **yet**?

They haven't started the work **yet**.

ALREADY = ja (+) *Position: between AUX and PARTICIPLE*

They have **already** arrived.

JUST = just, acabar de *Position: between AUX and PARTICIPLE*

She has **just** called.
