On **Pancake Day**, or Shrove Tuesday, pancake races are held in towns all over England. It's customary for women to run down the street, throwing a hot pancake in the air and catching it in a pan! Making pancakes is a good way to finish all the eggs and fat in the house before Lent, the period before Easter, when these foods are traditionally not eaten.

**Saint Patrick's Day** honours Saint Patrick, the patron saint of Ireland. In Ireland the festivities last all week, with over a million people coming to Dublin to join the fun, see the annual St. Patrick's Day parade and enjoy activities. But this day isn't celebrated only in Ireland – parades are held all over the world, from Asia to the USA. It was made an official holiday in Ireland in 1903.

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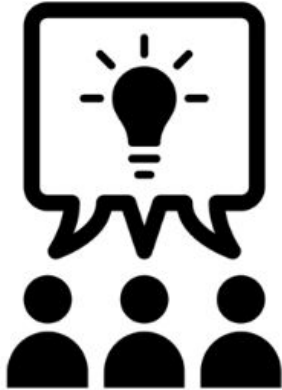

  - ★ Create an **original** design.
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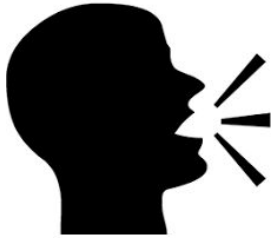
# Assessment (digital work)
