


A LITTLE DOG SAT UNDER A TREE.

3. Change the subject so that it's a different animal

4. Change the sentence so that it happens in the present

A LITTLE DOG SAT UNDER A LEAFY TREE.

A CUTE LITTLE DOG SAT UNDER A LEAFY TREE.

A CUTE LITTLE BUNNY SAT UNDER A LEAFY TREE.

A CUTE LITTLE BUNNY SITS UNDER A LEAFY TREE.



THE FRIDGE IS FULL OF APPLES AND BANANAS.

1.Use an adjective to describe the fridge

2. Change the sentence so that there is more than one fridge

3. Use another "and" and add some more food

4. Transform the sentence into a question




WHERE IS THE RED T-SHIRT?

1. Change the color which modifies the t-shirt

2. Change the piece of clothing

3.Add an extra adjective apart from the color

4.Provide an answer to the question




IT'S DIFFICULT TO REMEMBER ALL THESE MATH CONCEPTS.

1.Change the "it's" so it's not contracted

2.Change "difficult" by a synonym

3. Change the verb by another one which makes sense

4. Change the sentence so that it happens in the past



MY COUSIN SLEPT ON THE FLOOR.

1.Change the prepositional phrase

2.Change the possessive pronoun

3. Change the sentence so that it's past continuous

4.Use "because" and provide a reason




THE OLD LADY DANCED ALL NIGHT.

1.Add an adverb to describe how she danced

2.Change "all night" by another time adverbial

3. Change the sentence so that there is more than one lady

4.Add another adjective apart from "old"



WE WILL BUY A DARKER CARPET FOR THE BEDROOM.

1.Contract "we will"

2.Change "darker" by its antonym

3. Change the direct object

4.Add "but" and provide a contrasting sentence




"WHEN IS THE HISTORY TEACHER COMING?" SHE ASKED.

1. Change "asked" by a different verb with a similar meaning

2. Change the subject

3. Change the question so that it's past continuous

4. Change "coming" by another verb which makes sense

1. Change the direct object so that it's a different food

2. Transform the sentence into a negative one

3. Change the subject

4.Change the prepositional phrase




HIS FATHER LOOKED HAPPY.

1.Change the sentence so that it means the opposite

2. Change the subject so that it's a different member of the family

3. Change the sentence so that it happens in the present

4.Add "because" and provide a reason




2 DAYS AGO, WE ATE WAFFLES AND WE DRANK COFFEE.

1. Change the subject

2. Change the time adverbial

3.Add a prepositional phrase with "in" to show the place where it happened

4. Transform the sentence so that it's past continuous



THE SHOP WILL SELL DOLLS AND KITES.

1. Add an adjective to describe the direct object

2.Add another item that the shop will sell

3. Transform the sentence into negative

4.Add a time adverbial at the end



DOES THE HOTEL GIVE CLEAN TOWELS TO THE GUESTS?

1. Change the sentence so that there is more than one hotel

2.Change "clean" by another adjective

3.Add another item apart from towels

4. Change the question so that it refers to the future



I HAVE RECENTLY SEEN A MOVIE ABOUT VIKINGS.

1.Change the adverb

2. Change the subject

3.Change what the movie is about

4.Add "and" at the end and provide extra information




THERE ARE FIVE DESKS AND TWO CHAIRS IN THE LIBRARY.

1. Change the place adverbial

2.Add an adjective to describe the desks

3. Change the sentence so that it refers to the past

4. Transform the sentence into a question




THE CHILDREN WERE PRACTICING HANDBALL IN THE AFTERNOON.

1. Change the direct object so that it's a different sport

2.Add an adjective to describe the subject

3.Add an extra prepositional phrase

4.Add an adverb to describe how they were practicing it




I HAD TO TAKE A BUS TO GET TO THE CONFERENCE.

1.Change the verb so that it refers to the future

2.Add an adjective to describe the conference

3. Replace the direct object by a different means of transport

4.Add "because" and provide a reason




THEY WERE NOT USING THE COMPUTERS AT THAT MOMENT.

1.Contract "were not"

2. Change the direct object

3. Add an adjective to describe the direct object

4. Change the time adverbial



THAT PINK ARMCHAIR IS VERY EXPENSIVE.

1. Change the subject so that it's a different piece of furniture

2. Transform the sentence into a negative one

3. Change "expensive" by an antonym

4.Add "but" and provide a contrasting sentence



HER GRANDFATHER IS RESTING ON THAT SOFT SOFA.

1.Change the possessive pronoun

2. Change the verb so that it's simple present

3. Add an extra adjective to describe the sofa

4. Add a time adverbial
