

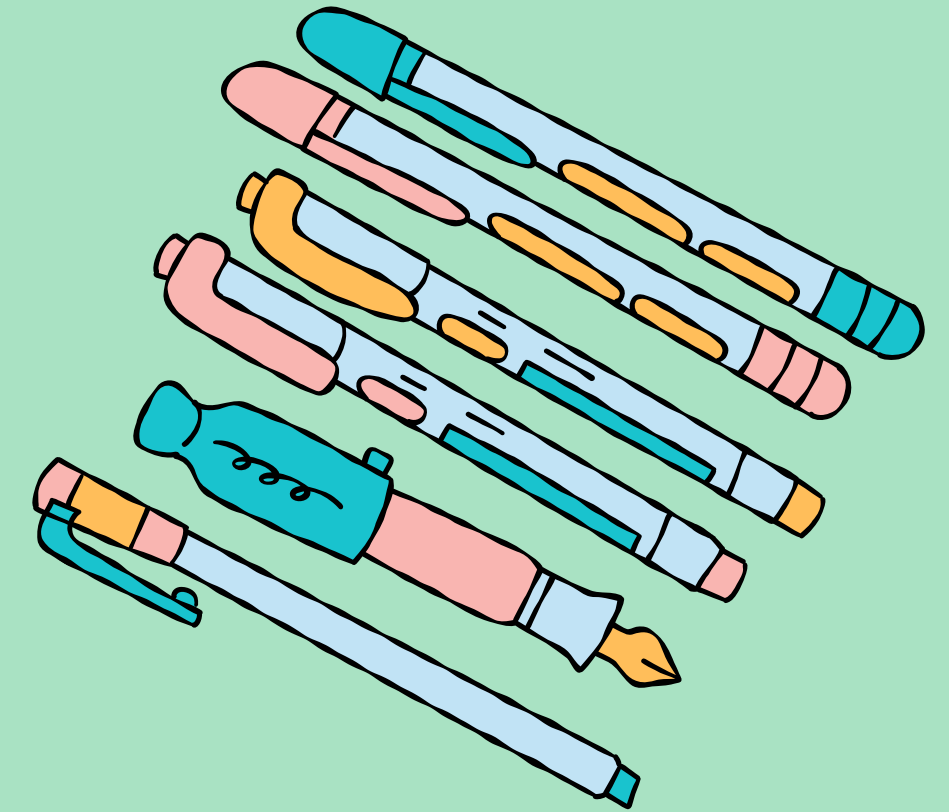
FORM - HOW DO WE MAKE COMPARATIVE AND SUPERLATIVE ADJECTIVES?

| TYPES OF ADJECTIVES | COMPARATIVE | SUPERLATIVE |
|--|-------------------------------|--------------------------------------|
| short (one syllable) | + -er | the + -est |
| one syllable adjectives ending in a vowel and then a consonant | double consonant + -er | the + double consonant + -est |
| two syllable adjectives ending in -y | delete -y + -ier | the + delete y + -iest |
| long adjectives (more than two syllables) | more + adjective | the most + adjective |
| irregular adjectives good, bad, far | no rule | no rule |
