ex: We have got **too much** homework.

UNCOUNTABLE

ex: He eats **too many** candies.

ENOUGH + NOUN

ex: I have **enough** time / I don't have **enough** time.

VERB + ENOUGH

ex: I don't sleep **enough**.

ADJECTIVE + ENOUGH

ex: My town is big **enough**.
