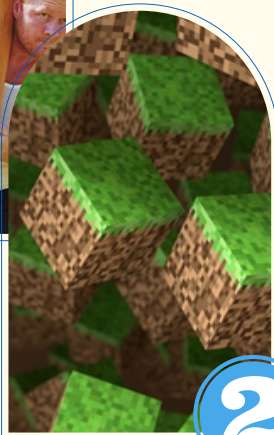
Regarding its famous landmarks, **Holyrood Palace** is the official residence of the monarch there (1).

Regarding its famous landmarks, **Seahorses sculptures** are all around the country, like the one at the entrance to the port (1).

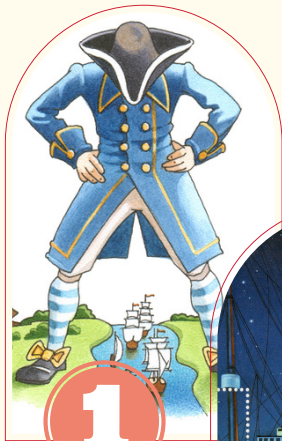
Another iconic landmark is **The Albert Memorial Clock**, similar to the Tower of Pisa (2).
