One of its curious facts is that it is home to **Cadbury** chocolate with the firstever Cadbury factory (1). Another significant fact is that, Romeo and Juliet's author, William **Shakespeare** the world's greatest playwright, was born there in 1564 (2).


As for its geographical places, **The Whaligoe steps** are cardved into the cliffside (1).

Another significant fact is that Belfast, its capital, produced the famous **Titanic** ship (2).
