

### Steps to follow:

1. Create a map and draw it
2. Include 6-8 different places (at least, 2 per person)
  - a. Explain what the building is, when was it built, why is it used for nowadays, what can people do there,...
  - b. Add an image or a drawing
  - c. Add any additional information
3. Presentation of the project (slides presentation)

### 7 sessions devoted to the project:

1. Explanation of the project, group formation, materials needed and tasks' organisation
2. Starting the project (we need to book some Chromebooks)
  - a. Map drawing and places location
3. Continuing the project
4. Project's cardboard
5. Slides presentation
6. Slides presentation
7. Project presentation
