It's NOT a for and against essay discussing about peaceful vs violent marches.

Topic 2:

“Violent video games contribute to youth violence”.

WRITING

Structure



1. The **introduction** and **conclusion** paragraphs NEED TO BE MUCH SHORTER than the **body**.
2. Give your opinion in the **introduction**. That will be your **THESIS STATEMENT**. Then, give **arguments** to support your thesis statement in the **body** paragraphs.
3. **Introduce** the topic **first**.
4. **Number of words**. Not penalized, but from now onwards, take it into account.
5. **Paragraphs** (image).
6. You need to SUPPORT giving ARGUMENTS (at least 3)

Content (introduction)

Introduction

A- Not appropriate

“Let’s talk about it”.

“In today’s opinion essay, I am going to write about...”

Example:

“In our society video games are very popular, but do violent video games contribute to youth violence? In my opinion, ...”

TASK 2.

Arguments

Good example:

“If you grow up with violent video games, you will normalize violence”.

Turn these ideas into ARGUMENTS:

“If they have a good education, they will become good people and they won’t be aggressive or violent”

“If video games are violent, the parents will have to forbid them or explain to their children that there are other games”

“Violence is caused by different factors, such as family problems, bullying or mental health issues”.

POSSIBLE ANSWERS

Turn these ideas into ARGUMENTS:

“If they have a good education, they will become good people and they won’t be aggressive or violent”

If they have a good education, they will distinguish between what’s good and bad and, therefore, know that videogames are just a way of having fun in a fictional world.

“If video games are violent, the parents will have to forbid them or explain to their children that there are other games”

Video games are a bad example for kids and, therefore, can contribute to youth violence. That’s why parents will have to forbid...

“Violence is caused by different factors, such as family problems, bullying or mental health issues. However, playing video games can’t be a factor as they are fictional”.
