

COMPARATIVES & SUPERLATIVES (A1)

· GRAMMAR USED: Verb TO BE (is/are, was/were)

1) LONG ADJECTIVES (3+ syllables): **more ... than ... / the most ...**

2) SHORT ADJECTIVES (1 syllable): **(- er) than / the (- est).**

3) TWO SYLLABLE ADJECTIVES:

A) Type «pretty»: short adjective.

B) Type «famous»: long adjective.

COMPARATIVES

1) E.g.: Mary is more famous than Peter.

2) E.g.: Mary is prettier than Peter.

SUPERLATIVES

1) E.g.: Mary is the most famous student.

2) E.g.: Mary is the prettiest student (in school).
