- 1) LONG ADJECTIVES (3+ syllables): more ... than ... / the most ...
- 2) SHORT ADJECTIVES (1 syllable): (- er) than / the (- est).
- 3) TWO SYLLABLE ADJECTIVES:
- A) Type «pretty»: short adjective.
- B) Type «famous»: long adjective.

## **COMPARATIVES**

- 1) E.g.: Mary is more famous than Peter.
- 2) E.g.: Mary is prettier than Peter.

## **SUPERLATIVES**

- 1) E.g.: Mary is the most famous student.
- 2) E.g.: Mary is the prettiest student (in school).
