

Aquí tienes una **conversación en inglés** diseñada para niños de 3 a 5 años, enfocada en aprender vocabulario meteorológico usando el **present simple**. Es corta, repetitiva y con gestos para que los niños participen:

Conversation: Weather Words ☀️❄️

Teacher: Hello, friends! Let's sit down and listen. Let's talk about the weather.

Teacher: When the sun is in the sky, we say: *It is sunny*.

Teacher: Can you say: *It is sunny*? **(make big sun arms)**

Teacher: When the rain falls, we say: *It is rainy*.

Teacher: Can you say: *It is rainy*? **(wiggle fingers like rain)**

Teacher: When the clouds cover the sky, we say: *It is cloudy*.

Teacher: Can you say: *It is cloudy*? **(make a cloud shape with arms)**

Teacher: When the wind blows, we say: *It is windy*.

Teacher: Can you say: *It is windy*? **(blow air with mouth)**

Teacher: When the snow falls, we say: *It is snowy*.

Teacher: Can you say: *It is snowy*? **(pretend to catch snowflakes)**

Teacher: Great job! Let's remember:

- It is sunny ☀️
- It is rainy
- It is cloudy ☁️
- It is windy
- It is snowy ❄️

Teacher: Now, look outside. What is the weather today?

Consejo: acompaña cada palabra con gestos y dibujos (sol, nube, lluvia, viento, nieve). Así los niños asocian el vocabulario con la experiencia visual y corporal.
