

ORAL TEST – PAIR WORK

Incarceration and Social Integration (B1)

Level: B1

Format: Pair work oral exam

Time: 8–10 minutes per pair

PREPARATION 1 & 2 – in your own language

PART 1 – WARM-UP (2 minutes)

Instructions: Talk with your partner and answer the questions.

- What does *incarceration* mean?
 - Why do people go to prison?
 - Do you think prison should help people change? Why?
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PART 2 – INFORMATION EXCHANGE (3 minutes)

Each student speaks about their topic. Then, ask your partner at least **one question**.

Student A – Life in Prison

Talk about:

- Daily routine
- Rules
- Relationships
- Problems in prison

Student B – Causes of Incarceration

Talk about:

- Social problems (poverty, education, addiction, etc.)
 - Personal decisions
 - Prevention
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STUDENT ROLE CARDS – A

ROLE CARD A – SOCIAL INTEGRATION PROFESSIONAL

Situation:

Your partner has just left prison. You work as a social integration professional.

Goal:

Help the person integrate into society and avoid returning to prison.

Your tasks:

- Welcome the person
- Ask about their situation
- Offer help and solutions

Ask about (at least two):

- Job or work experience
- Education or training
- Family or social support
- Housing
- Future plans

Useful questions:

- How do you feel after leaving prison?
 - Do you have work experience?
 - What problems do you have now?
 - How can I help you?
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STUDENT ROLE CARDS – B

ROLE CARD B – EX-PRISONER

Situation:

You have just left prison and need support.

Goal:

Explain your needs clearly and accept support.

Your tasks:

- Explain your situation
- Talk about your difficulties
- Ask for help

Talk about (at least two):

- Problems finding a job
- Lack of education or training
- Family situation
- Social rejection
- Fear of reoffending

Useful phrases:

- I need help with...
 - I am worried about...
 - It is difficult for me to...
 - I would like to...
