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

= Des de fa quant de temps?

1. How long have you lived in this city?
2. How long have they been married?

1. I've lived in this city for 5 years.
2. They've been married for 20 years.

1. I've lived in this city since 2018.
2. They've been married since 2003.

KEY WORDS:

FOR = ja

duration

- for 2 years
- for a long time

1. I've lived in this city for 5 years.

2. They've been married for 20 years.

SINCE = des de

starting point

- since 2018
- since Monday

1. I've lived in this city since 2018.

2. They've been married since 2003.

KEY WORDS:

ALREADY → finished earlier than expected

= ja

I have **already** eaten.

JUST → finished very recently

= just ara

I have **just** finished.

YET → not finished, but expected to be

→ *always at the end of sentence*

= encara no (-)

I **haven't** finished **yet**.

= ja (?)

Have you finished **yet**?





USE

1. Accions que han passat en algun moment del passat, però no es diu quan.


We've visited London.

Paraules prohibides:

- yesterday
- last week
- in 2022
- when I was 10

✗ I have seen her **yesterday**.

✓ I saw her **yesterday**.



- since / for → present perfect
- ahir, last year, in 2012 → past simple
