STEP 1:

BRAINSTORMING

Brainstorm all the skills you know.

STEP 2:

1. TELL (Explain the skill)

- What is it?
- Why is it useful / fun?
- What materials do we need?
- Key vocabulary

“Today we are going to teach you how to...”

“First, you need...”

“This is useful because...”

STEP 3:

2. 👁️ 👁️ SHOW (Demonstrate)

- Model the skill slowly
- Speak clearly
- Use gestures
- Use visual support (real objects)

“Watch carefully.”

“First..., then..., after that..., finally...”

“Pay attention to...”

STEP 4:

3. 🖐️ PRACTISE (Classmates try!)

- Give clear instructions
- Help and correct politely
- Encourage participation

“Now it’s your turn.”

“Try again.”

“Good job!”

“Remember to...”
