

Project: Biography of an Important Woman in My Life

1. Choose the Woman

Select **one important woman**. She can be:

- A family member (mother, grandmother, aunt, sister)
- A teacher or mentor
- A historical or public figure
- A community member.
- Make sure you can **find enough information** about her.

2. Look for information


You must collect information from **at least 2 sources**:

If she is someone you know:

- Conduct an interview (prepare 8–10 questions)
- Ask about her life, challenges, achievements, and values

If she is a public figure:

- Use books, articles, or reliable websites

 Focus on:

- Early life (birth, childhood)
- Education and career
- Important achievements
- Challenges or obstacles
- Why she is important to you

3. Organize your biography

Write your biography using this structure:

1. Introduction

- Who is she?
- Why did you choose her?

2. Early Life

- Where and when was she born?
- Family background

3. Main Life Events

- Education, career, major experiences

4. Achievements & Impact

- What did she accomplish?
- How has she influenced others?

5. Personal Reflection

- Why is she important to you?
- What did you learn from her?

4. Create your final product

Choose **one format**:

- Poster
- Infographic
- Canva presentation

Be creative! Include:

- Photos
- Quotes
- Timeline or key facts

5. Present your work

You will present your project to the class:

- Speak clearly and confidently
- Highlight the most important parts
- Keep within the time limit
