Future Continuous

The Future Continuous (o futur progressiu) is a verb tense used in English to talk about actions that will be in progress at a specific time in the future. In Catalan, it is equivalent to structures such as "estaré fent".

Structure

Es forma amb l'auxiliar **will be** seguit del verb principal acabat en **-ing**. També és possible utilitzar **be going to be + -ing**, tot i que és menys habitual en contextos formals.

Subject + will be + verb -ing



Subject + will not (won't) be + verb -ing



Will + subject + be + verb -ing?

Examples

Examples

Affirmative ✓

- I **will**/I'll be going to Palma.
- It **will**/It'll be playing with the ball.
- She **will**/She'll be reading a book.



Negative ✗

- You **will not**/You **won't** be sleeping on Saturday night.
- She **will not**/She **won't** be cooking a cake.
- I **will not**/I **won't** be working.



Examples

Interrogative ?

- **Will I be** skiing tomorrow?
- **Will she be** eating at 12pm?
- **Will they be** watching a movie?

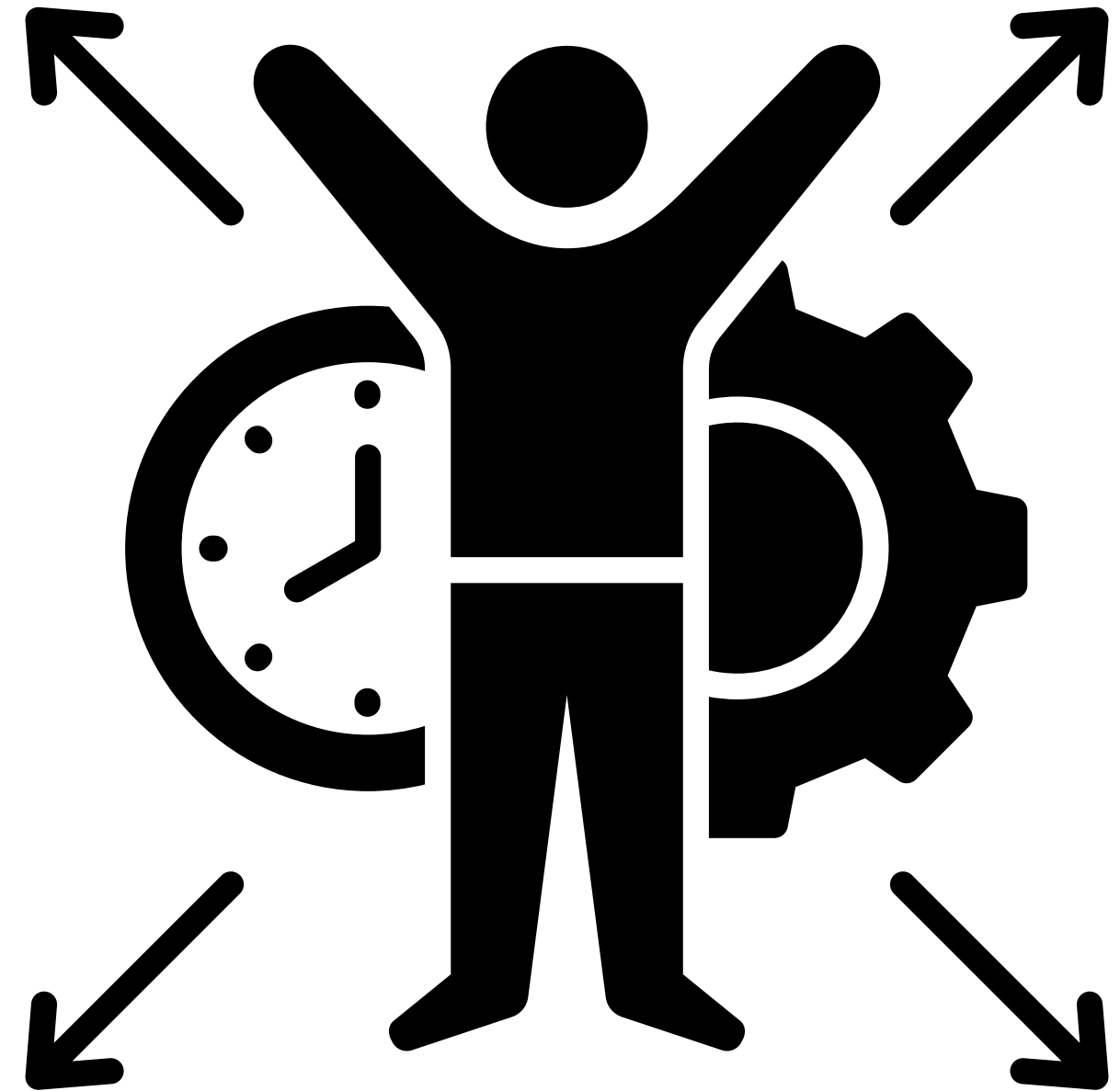
